
☐ IN the current Short &

Of 11 plays in Week 2 at Newtown Theatre, *Uncomfortable Silences* received an unprecedented 39.7 per cent of the popular vote, taking it above last year's People's Choice winner *Being Frank* (30.3 per cent) and the 2004 winner *The Ready to Fit Pergola Kit* (23.9 per cent).

It was also the first pick of 9 out of 11 judges making *Uncomfortable Silences* the winner of the judges' voting by 16 points.
